

CUESTA COLLEGE COMMUNITY PROGRAMS YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCEDURES

PURPOSE:

The Community Programs Department scholarship program is made possible through the generous donations of community members who support the Cuesta College Foundation. The purpose of this program is to assist economically disadvantaged youths to participate in enrichment programs and classes offered by the College's Community Programs Department.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Must be 17 years of age or younger to receive funding.
2. Participant/Student must be a resident of San Luis Obispo County
3. Full and partial scholarships will be awarded depending on funds available, the number of applicants, and the cost of the class the scholarship would be used for.
4. Children are eligible for one scholarship per program.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD PROCESS:

1. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of need.
2. Application must be **COMPLETELY** filled out by the applicant and a parent/guardian.
3. Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Awards Committee.
4. If your child is awarded a scholarship, the amount of the scholarship will be "credited" in their name for use towards the registration of a **FUTURE** class (not currently enrolled).
5. If you are concerned about a specific class filling up, we recommend that you pre-register for that class and use the scholarship towards a class that is less likely to fill.
6. Scholarships have no cash/refund value and are valid through **August 5, 2010**.
